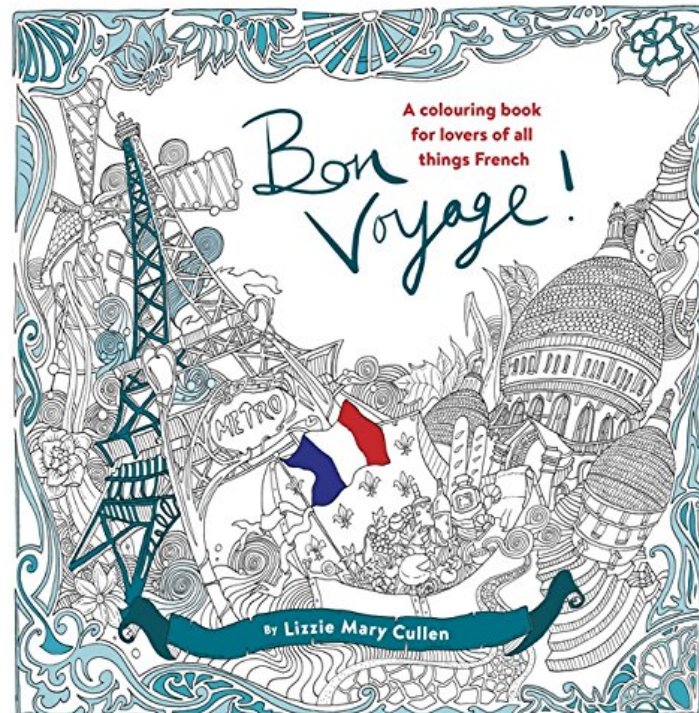

They look a bit intimidating at first but they open up incredibly as you colour the images. I was expecting similar images in this book, although focused on aspects of French culture and geography.Here comes the surprise! You have to read the cover blurb carefully before you come to the hint.This is a book of French proverbs, mostly single-sided images, that are based more on the French language (quite literally interpreted at times), with added French iconic details. Within each image are aspects of French culture, some of them quite hard to find.Having coloured one image, the book is growing on me.In colouring these images, I think I'm going to see something very different to the usual French themed colouring books out there.
