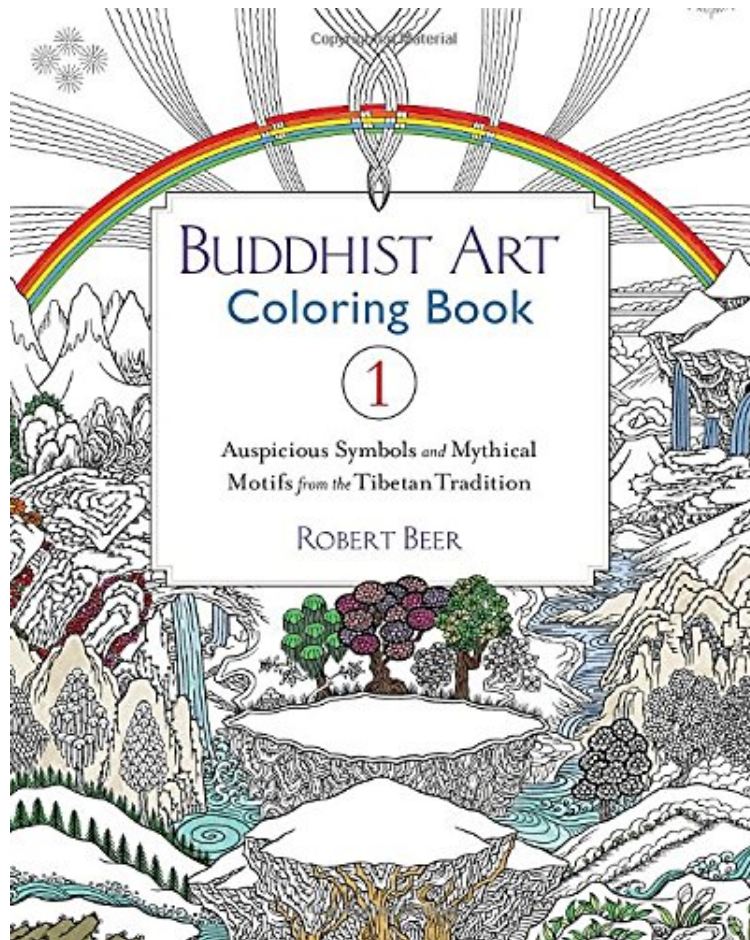

The paper I would guess is about 65-80 lb paper that's semi-glossy, so it can hold up to light watercoloring but it's definitely not heavy watercolor paper.
