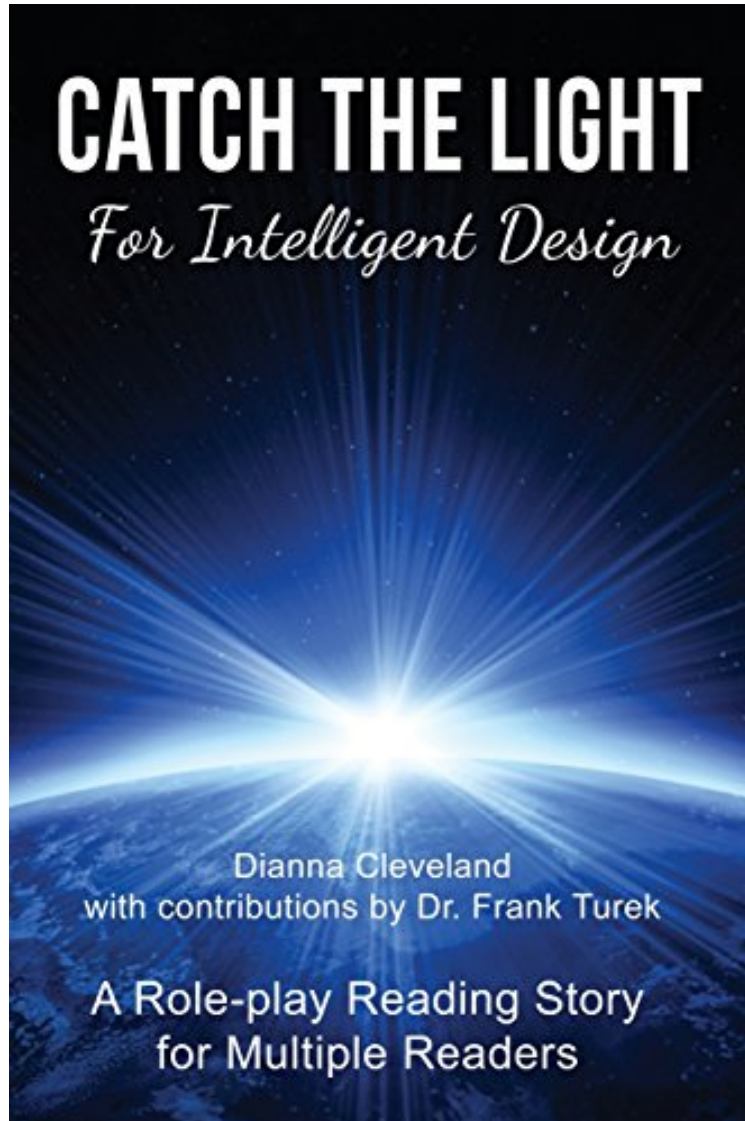

I valued the succinct logical arguments presented in an engaging manner. As with any idea, there will never be complete agreement on this side of heaven. I do not agree with the term "micro-evolution." I think it can be misleading as evolution implies a gain of genetic information. Adaptation and/or gene plasticity may be better terms because, as Dianna correctly explained, we only observe the pre-coded ability of genes to change according to certain stimuli. No new information can be added without intelligent intervention in the lab. I also don't agree with the idea of comparing the Big Bang with Genesis 1:1. The Big Bang was a random chaotic explosive event that somehow created matter and order. Genesis 1:1 explains an intelligent action converting energy into matter, the total opposite of an explosion. Overall I highly recommend this audiobook.

In this first book of the Catch the Light three-part series, evidence for Intelligent Design is taught through role-play reading similar to the format of a theatrical play. In this fun and entertaining fictional story, an atheist becomes engaged in conversation about the origin of the universe with a variety of people as they come and go in a coffee shop. As many of the common arguments for and against Intelligent Design are discussed, the atheist is both figuratively and literally enlightened as he learns about the vast amount of evidence for the existence of a divine creator. With each new bit of information, he catches a glimpse of light (evidenced by the white spots appearing on his black shirt throughout the discussion). By the end of the series, his shirt becomes completely white. With contemporary and amusing dialogue, this story is fun and interesting to read aloud by a small group and makes for an inspiring and engaging performance. The book is published in the patented Playbook® format with color-coded dialogue and easier and harder roles. The series includes the upcoming continuing stories, Catch the Light for the Bible and Catch the Light for Jesus.
