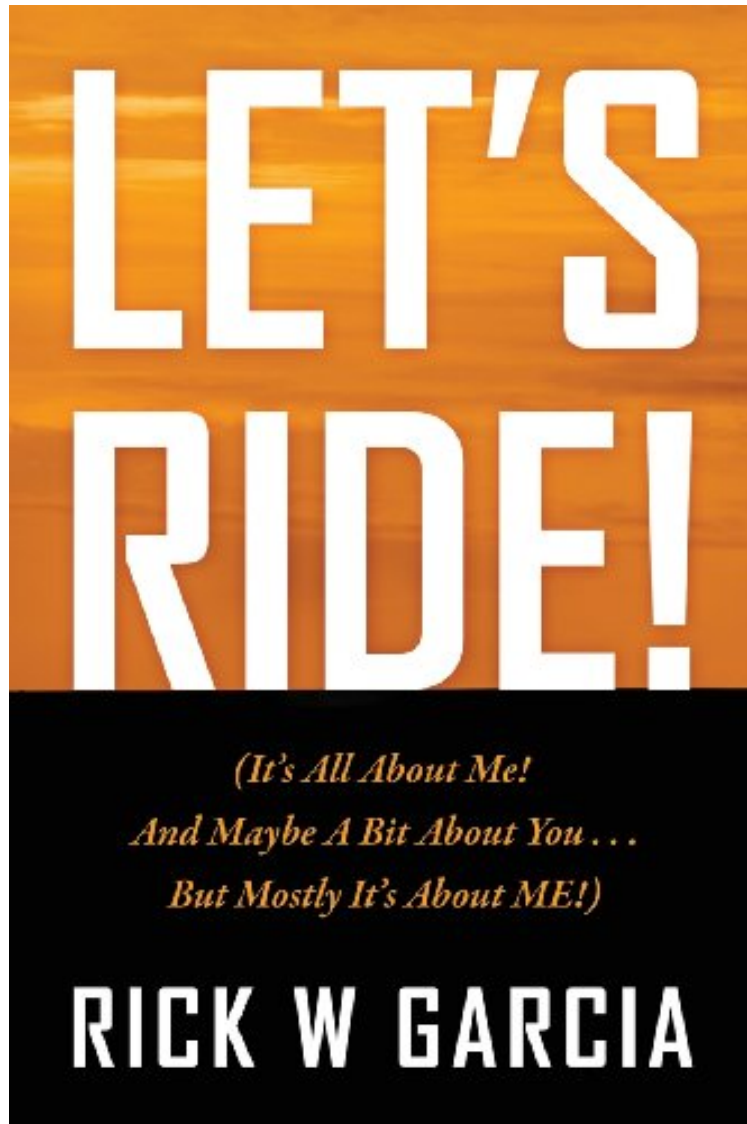

About the Author Rick W Garcia was born on the wrong side of the tracks. He grew up in a small town called Lexington, located in central Nebraska. In 1973, Rick became the newest member of the Chadron, Nebraska Police Department and, six years later, an instructor at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. While at the academy, he got involved with an international training organization that trained law enforcement, military, and private security in the use of force—mostly nonlethal. In 1990 he jumped at the chance to go to Saudi Arabia and train their Royal Air Defense Force Military Police. A little thing called the Gulf War postponed his new adventure, but soon afterward, he found himself living in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, where he eventually became the Deputy Director of Training. Currently Rick and his wife live on a "farm" in the middle of the desert, 60 miles outside of Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and he works directly for a high-ranking member of the Saudi royal family. Let's Ride is his first book, and it is dedicated to his grandchildren, who live too far away.
