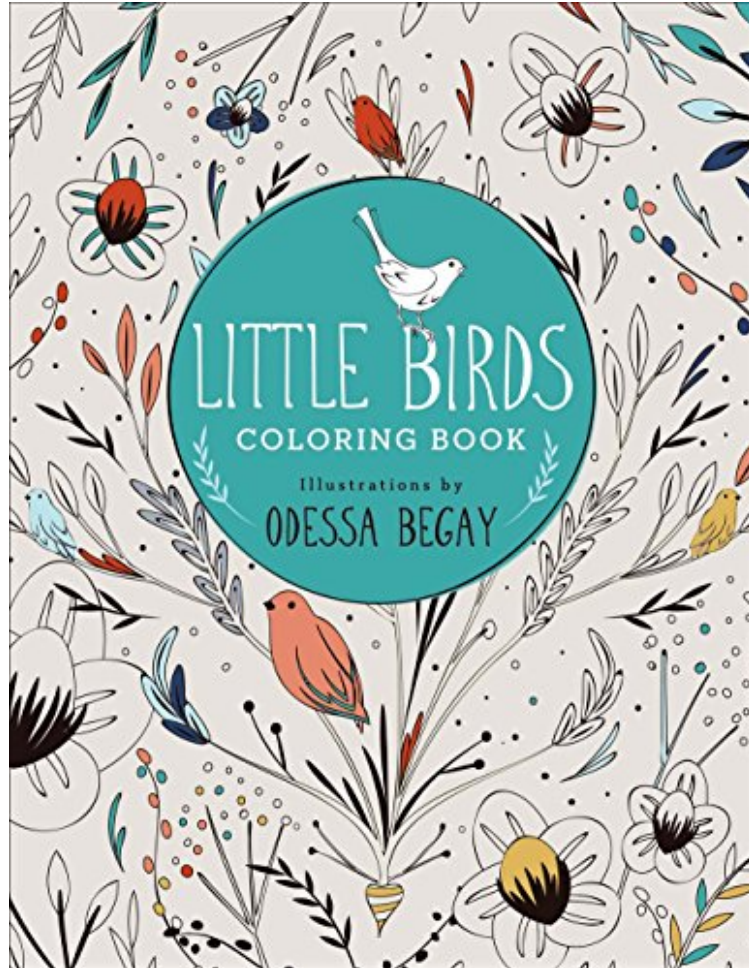

By Cindy Butler Summary: "Little Birds" contains 120 full size images, 6 pages of introductory material, and 2 pages of miscellaneous information in the back. It measures 7.5 x 9.75 inches and is sewn into a matte finish cover with foil accents. Featuring intricately detailed line drawings, this book is appropriate for adult colorists on all skill levels. Paper: The paper in this book is bright white and about twice the thickness of standard copy weight. All pages are double sided and non-perforated. Dry mediums will be okay to use, but any wet products may cause bleedthrough (test on a text page first). As always, be sure to place several sheets of blotter paper under your current picture to prevent any color transfer. Artwork: As the

title implies, "Little Birds" focuses strongly on the avian world with lots of botanicals mixed in. Some of the included images are based on real plants and animals, while others are 100% imaginary. Inside you'll see warblers, finches, irises, woodpeckers, and more. There are also lots of bird cages, nests, vases, and patterns scattered throughout for a nice variety (you'll even see a turkey). All of the artwork is inspired by traditional European folk art and there are some "add your own" pages for the colorist to doodle feathers, flowers, etc... The majority of the images are a single page, but there are around 8 double spreads included as well. Nearly every picture reaches the edges of the page, so removing them would be difficult. Print quality is nicely done and the detail level is consistently high. Picture completion time should range from 3-10 hours (may be slightly different for each individual). Overall, this is a very pretty book with a fun theme. It would be best suited for chalk/pencil colorists who enjoy intricate imagery. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
