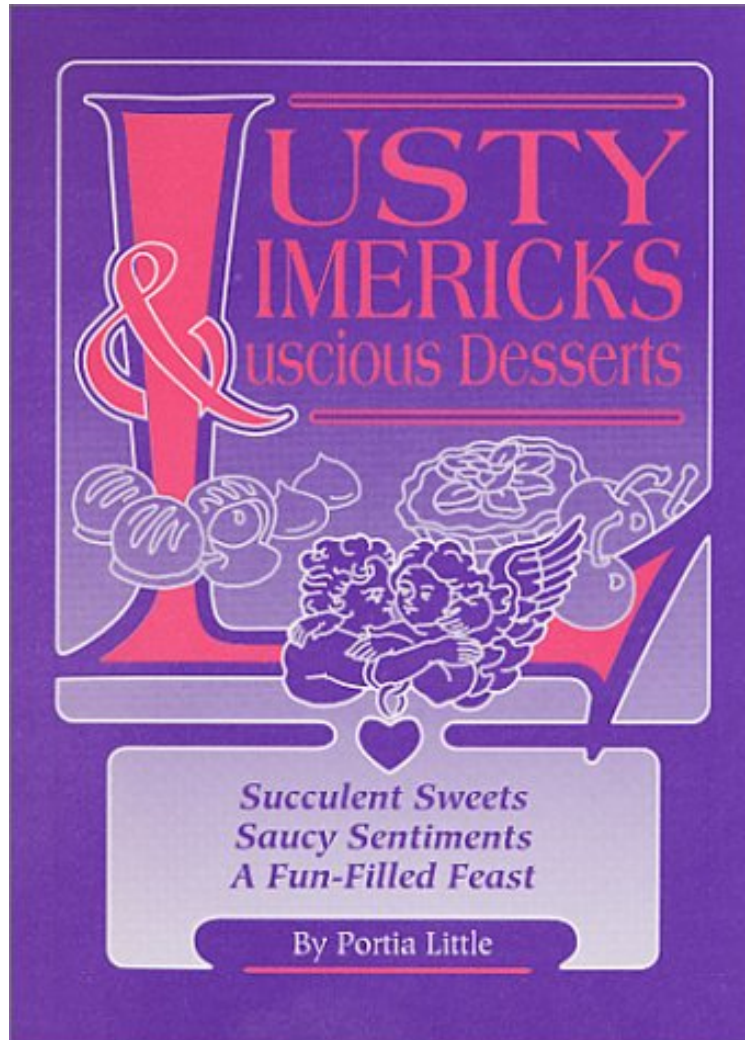

They are all in good taste and quite funny. Her recipes are easy-to-follow and mouth-watering. They only require ingredients found at your grocery store, as well as tools in a regular kitchen. This fun-filled feast of succulent sweets and saucy sentiments features luscious, easy-to-prepare desserts including cakes, pies, cookies, bread puddings, tarts, and cheesecakes.
