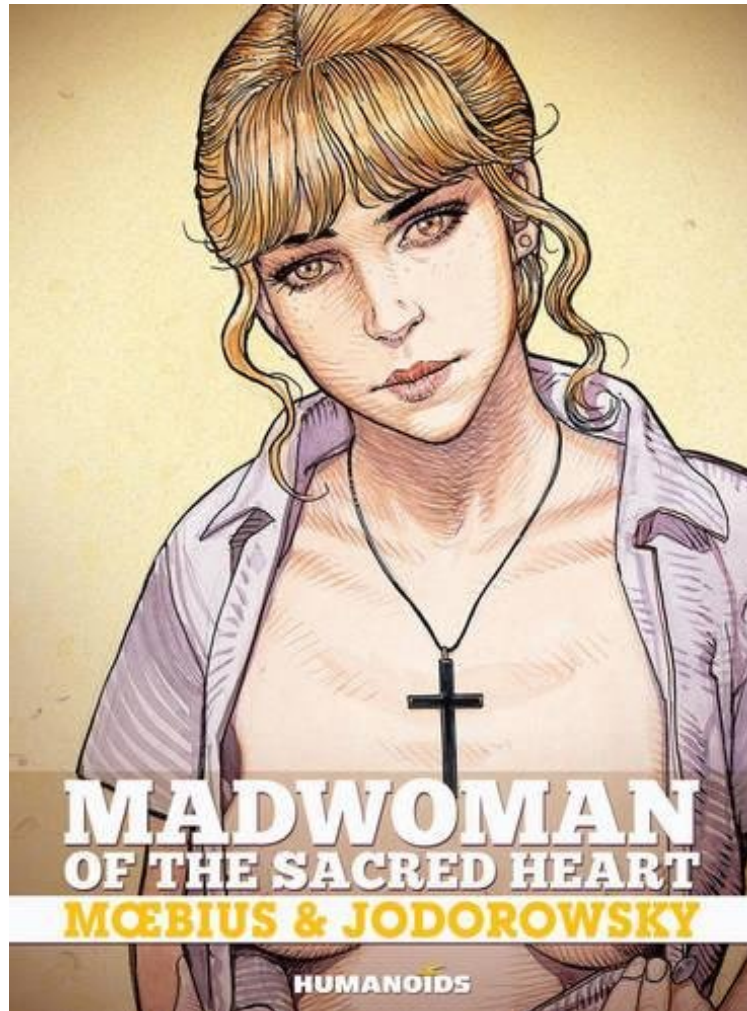

The artwork is more naturalistic and engaging than some of Jodorowski and Moebius's more futuristic work.
