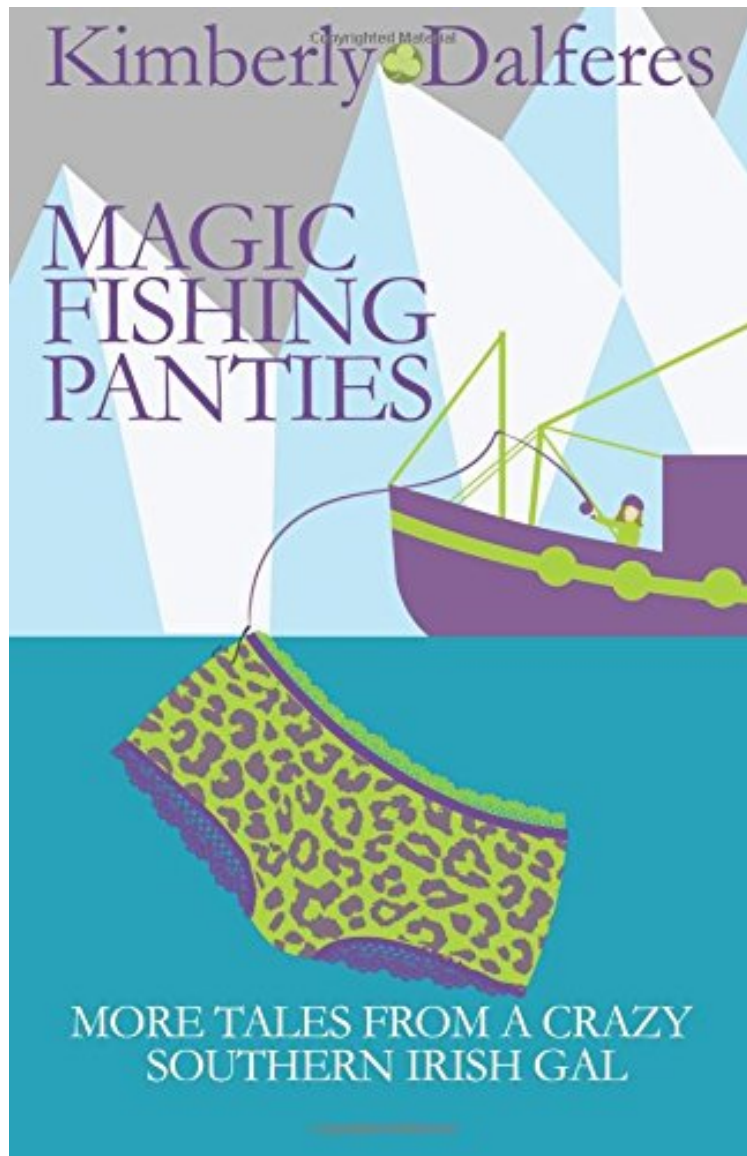

This collection of humorous tales offers new perspective from the self-proclaimed crazy Southern Irish gal and recent inductee into Club 50. Rather than wallow in the self-pity often induced by sagging jaw lines, empty nests, and menopause, the author offers colorful depictions of life in the middle.
