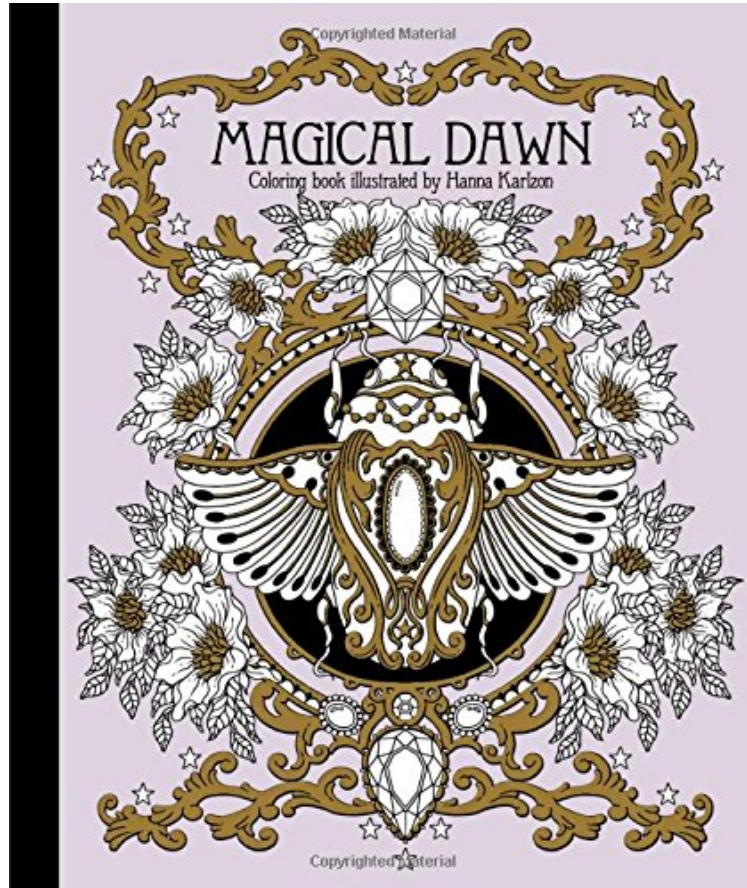

I pre-ordered this book months ago and the wait was well worth it! Hanna Karlzon's books are all excellent books.The quality of the paper, and the design of the book, hard-covered, makes it a true gem to have an any colorists library. Another thing that I like about her books, is that they have over 90 pages of coloring. Imagine that! You have quality, price, and amazing content, which together makes Magical Dawn a completely fantastic book. iiiiireader[[VIDEOID:92630a7d900e0b398f1722513f65c803]]I own a few coloring books by Hanna Karlzon and I was looking forward to receiving *Magical Dawn* which I purchased sight unseen on pre-order. The book is filled with designs in Ms. Karlzon's unique style. I think that the designs in this book are even more elaborate than her previous ones. There are many more jewels, animals, and lovely ladies. Because the book is printed two-sided, I'm being very careful with what I use to color in it. I've discovered that I prefer using my Faber-Castell Polychromos because 1) I like the way they work with the paper and 2) I like the color mix available for these designs. I also like to use metallic and glitter gel pens to add a hint of pizzazz to my projects. This has been true with my other copies of regular hardbound coloring books by Ms. Karlzon. I like her artist edition and postcard versions for use with my markers as those editions are printed only on one side of the page. This is what I found while coloring in this book and testing it with my coloring medium. I will list the coloring medium I use for tests and coloring in the comments section below. 90+ pages of beautiful and elaborate designs by Hanna Karlzon. Printed on both sides of the page. Paper is heavyweight, cream color, somewhat smooth, and non-perforated. Sewn binding with some glue as well. You can still snip the threads to remove the pages from the book but may have to contend with a tiny bit of glue on a few pages. I've not tried this as I want to keep my book together. Some designs merge into the binding area, especially those which spread across two pages. Because of the sewn/glued binding and the hardcover of the book, it is difficult to color into those bits. It makes it more of a challenge to tilt the book to get the right angle for coloring. Alcohol-based markers bleed through the page. If you use these, you will have ink seep through and mar the design on the back of the page. Water-based markers, gel pens and India ink pens do not bleed through the page. Colored pencils work well with the paper. I was able to blend, layer the same and multiple colors using both oil and wax-based pencils with ease.

Magical Dawn by bestselling artist Hanna Karlzon, boasts 96-pages of sparkling crystals, fluttering wings, and mushroom-studded abodes. The beautiful hardbound edition encourages artists to display their copy on a coffee table or bookshelf, and makes a great gift. The variety of formats in each of Hannah Karlzon's unique collections encourages collecting and gifting. Hanna Karlzon who has an art teaching degree from Umeå University, has run her own business as a freelance designer since 2013. *Magical Dawn* is her third coloring book series, following her debut of *Daydreams* and *Summer Nights* in 2016.

About the Author Hanna Karlzon is an Umeå, Sweden-based illustrator and creator of the best-selling coloring books, *Dagdrömmar* and *Sommarnatt*, previously published in Sweden. She creates elaborately detailed images using India ink to detail pictures from her own imagination and loves to draw flowers, forests, houses, and animals. She draws her inspiration from the natural world that surrounds her studio in northern Sweden and adds in some art nouveau, punk rock, and often a hint of '70s design to the mix.
