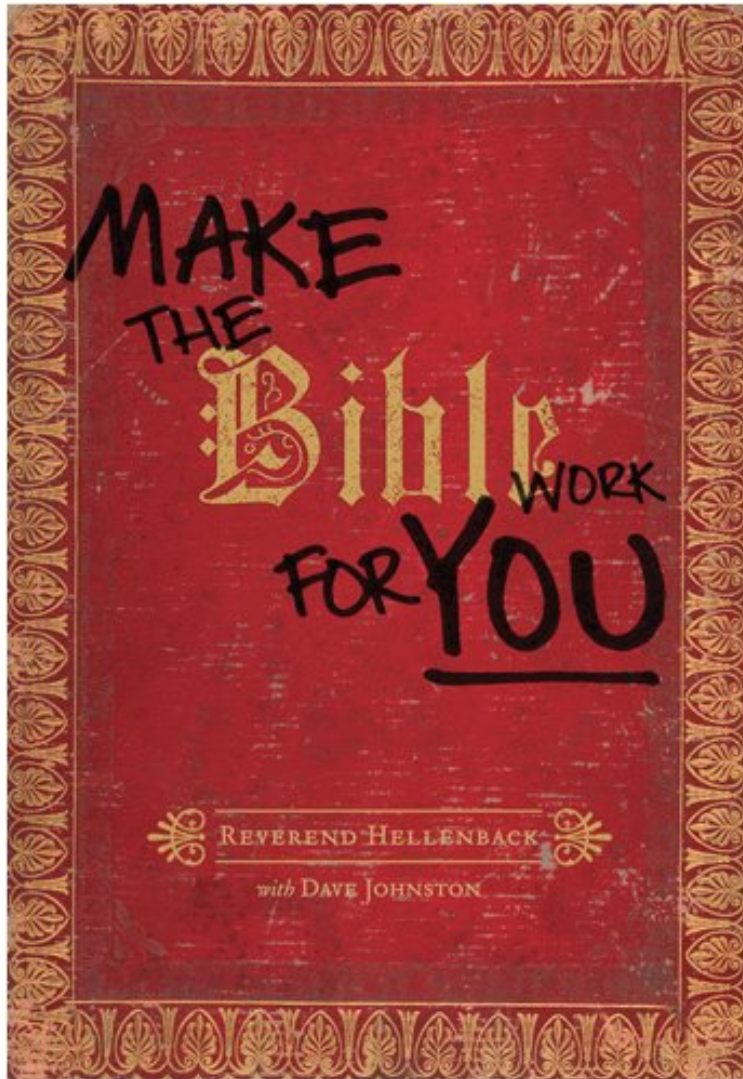

It covers basically every type of humor there is, and really makes ya laugh- and double -check a scripture now and again. For those of a more adventurous nature, it may also lend ideas of future antics (i.e. taking Casual Friday up a notch by going pants free). Each antic/idea/joke/thought-of-the-day is one page long (or shorter), so it's a good book for a little pick me up when you've got no time to think positive. It would also make a great gift. The binding is beautiful, there's gold foiling on the pages, there's even a cloth book mark. It looks like a gift book. Actually, it looks like a Bible that's been graffiti'd, but that works too.

Ever feel a little guilty for a white lie or for "borrowing" something without asking first? Wondering what Jesus would have done? Now there's no need!
