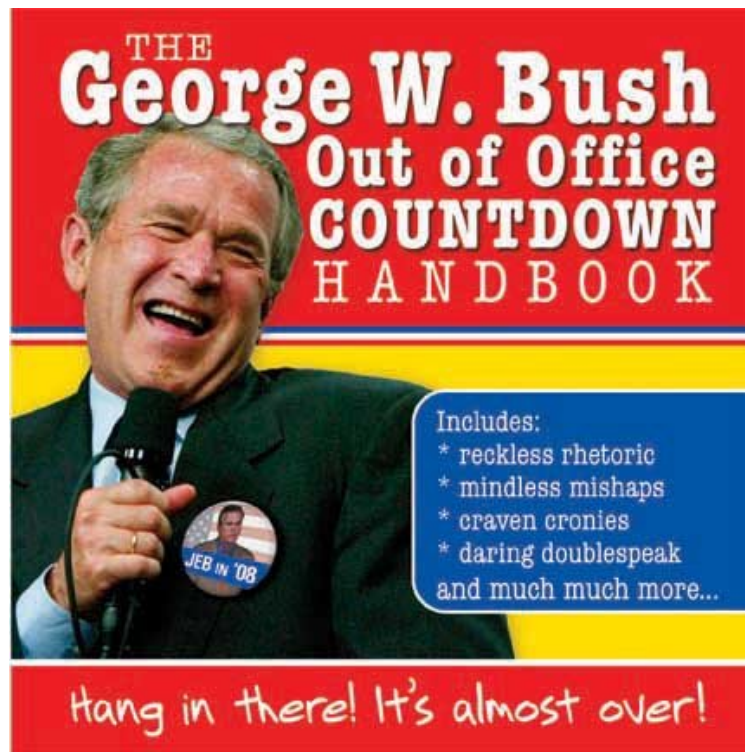


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The George W. Bush Out of Office Countdown Handbook: Hang in There! It's Almost Over!
