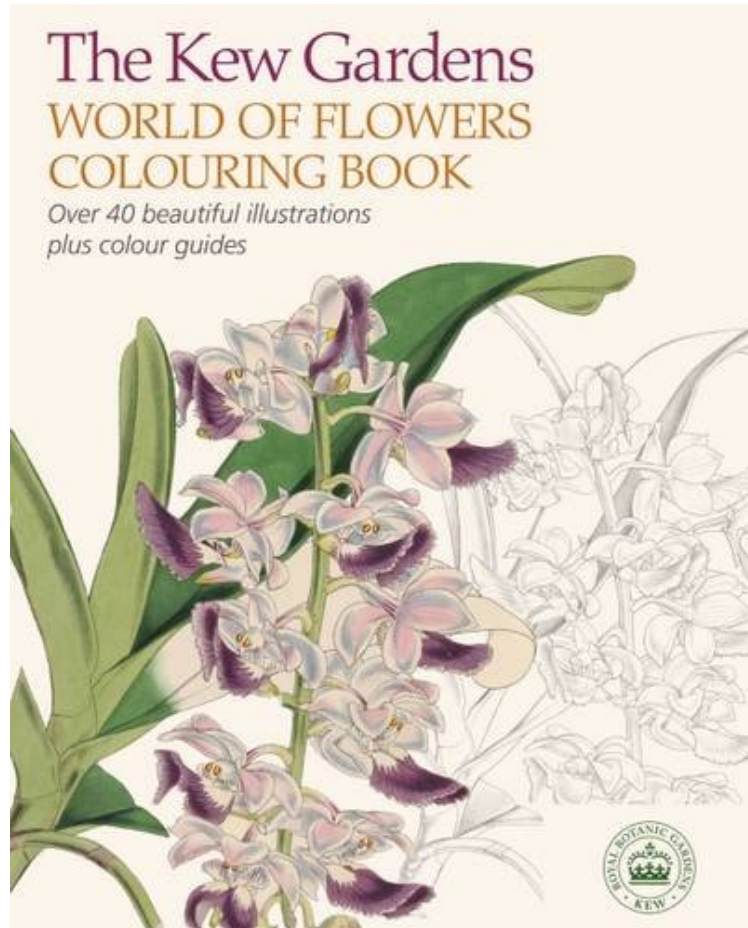

Along with delicate beauties like *Prunus cerasifera* and *Tinnea aethiopica*, this collection of 44 floral engravings to

color also includes some blooms that might have made a proper Victorian lady blush, like *Philodendron erubescens* and *Swainsona maccullochiana*. For more than 100 years, after moving publication to Kew in 1841, the hand-drawn and colored illustrations in Curtis's *Botanical Magazine* were made from live specimens at the Royal Botanic Gardens. This coloring book presents 44 of the magazine's beautiful full-page illustrations-nearly all of them drawn by the prolific Walter Hood Fitch-pairing the final colored versions with the uncolored engravings. Use the original as a guide for your coloring efforts, or strike out on your own and give these floral drawings a personal creative touch.
